



ASSEMBLY DISTRICTS

Are fixed by the board of aldermen, pursuant to the laws of 1892, chapter 397.

ALDERMANIC DISTRICTS

Made the same as assembly districts, by the laws of 1892, chapter 408, except that the two districts above the Harlem River are the same as the wards.

The Twenty-ninth district includes also Riker's Island, by virtue of the laws of 1884, chapter 262, section 3, which includes Riker's Island within the Twenty-third ward.
