

1st Lieutenant Peter Gerald Lehman

Born January 17, 1917

Educated Deerfield Academy and Williams College, Class of 1940

Enlisted Royal Canadian Air Force in September 1941. Trained in Canada. Received his wings as Sgt. Pilot September 1942

Went overseas with the Royal Canadian Air Force October 1942

Served with Canadian Air Force until March 1943 when transferred to the United States Air Force with rank of 2nd Lieutenant

Assigned to 306th Fighter Squadron based in England

Had 57 missions over Germany as Fighter Pilot flying Thunderbolts and Mustangs

Awarded Air Medal with 5 clusters, and the Distinguished Flying Cross in 1944

Promoted to 1st Lieutenant

Killed in flight maneuvers over England on March 31, 1944, and is buried in the American Military Cemetery at Cambridge, England.
