Dear Mr. Szold:

I refer to your letter of April 16th addressed to Senator Lehman.

The Senator asked me to try and get clear answers to your questions. Milk marketing and pricing appears to be a pretty complicated subject. We took up this matter with the Department of Agriculture, but in our opinion their reply did not clarify the situation. I then talked with Judge Maguire in New York who has been following this subject closely and sent him your letter. Judge Maguire returned your letter with a note which is enclosed. I think it would be a good idea for you or one of your representatives to see Dr. Blanford as Judge Maguire suggests. He is a "milk expert" and we sincerely hope he can be helpful to you in clarifying the questions you have raised.

I regret your letter was not acknowledged more promptly.
