## Biography

Ada María Isasi-Díaz was born on March 22, 1943 in La Habana, Cuba. She left Cuba in 1960 as a political refugee. She graduated with a Bachelor of Arts, with a major in European History from the College of New Rochelle, New York in 1971. In January 1967 she arrived in Lima, Peru to join the Ursuline sisters as a missionary, serving in the María Madre de Dios Parish as a Junior High School teacher until 1969. In May 1977 Isasi-Díaz earned an M.A. in Medieval History from State University of New York at Brockport and a permanent certificate as High School Teacher in New York in 1978. From Union Theological Seminary in New York she received a Master of Divinity in 1985, an M.Phil in 1989, and a Ph.D. in Christian Social Ethics in 1990. She has received an honorary degree, Doctor of Laws, from Lynchburg College in Virginia.

From 1978 to 1982 Isasi-Díaz served as Regional Developer on the Office Ministerial Team of the Women's Ordination Conference in Rochester, New York. Isasi-Díaz began lecturing and writing in 1982. She was invited to lecture at Union Theological Seminary prior to beginning her doctoral program. Between 1987 and 1990 she served as a Director of Programs and Associate General Director of Church Women United in New York. Drew University in Madison, New Jersey appointed Isasi-Díaz as professor of Ethics and Theology at Drew University, Madison, New Jersey, in 1991, where she founded the Hispanic Institute of Theology in 1992.

Isasi-Díaz is an activist-theologian involved in the feminist theological movement. She has worked on developing and elaborating a *Mujerista* theology, a theology from a U.S. Latina perspective. The Sister Fund: Theological Renaissance Project is one of the movements Isasi-Díaz has been involved with and she is an active member of EATWOT, [www.eatwot.org](http://www.eatwot.org), whose records are also in the Burke Library Archives (see [http://www.columbia.edu/cu/lweb/img/assets/6400/WAB\\_EATWOT.pdf](http://www.columbia.edu/cu/lweb/img/assets/6400/WAB_EATWOT.pdf))

On several occasions Isasi-Díaz has returned to teach at Seminario Ecueménico de Teología in Cuba. She continues to elaborate *Mujerista* theology in conversation with liberation and other women-centered theologies.

## Collection Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of lectures, correspondence, working papers, publications, and other related materials from the files of Ada María Isasi-Díaz. The materials in this collection span much of her professional career as an activist and theologian, although the bulk of the material is from the 1970s through to the early 2000s. The bulk of the collection consists of minutes, correspondence, and newsletters from her work with women's organizations, as well as manuscripts of her lectures and publications. Also included are audiotapes, videotapes, personal correspondence, published articles, and clippings from magazines and newspapers.

The collection is divided into eight series:

- **Series 1: Women's Ordination Conference / Rochester Regional Task Force, 1975-1989 (6 Boxes [1 – 6], 3.0 linear ft.)**  
 This series contain notes, correspondence, committee minutes, and reports relating to Isasi-Díaz's work as a member of the Women's Ordination Conference and the Rochester Regional Task Force. It also contains some reports done for Las Hermanas organization and resource articles prepared for WOC. The series is alphabetical by organization (Hermanas, RRTF, WOC) and type (contracts, correspondence, minutes, newsletter, programs, proposals, reports), and then chronological. Some materials are in Spanish.
- **Series 2: Lectures and Conferences, 1978 – 2007 (4 Boxes [7 – 8b], 1.75 linear ft.)**  
 Series 2 contains personal correspondence, drafts, outlines, programs, newspaper and magazine clippings of public lectures presented by Isasi-Díaz. This series also contains Isasi-Díaz's homilies and syllabi. Arrangement is by type and chronological. In case of materials with no dates the arrangement is alphabetical when titled. Some materials are in Spanish, and some newspaper clippings are in Italian and German.

- **Series 3: Publications, 1966- 1999 (2 Boxes [9 – 9A], 0.75 linear ft.)**  
Series 3 contains articles, book reviews of Isasi-Díaz's books, consent forms, correspondence all relating to her publications. There are also unpublished articles and Bible Studies in this series. Some materials are in Spanish. Student papers are subject to FERPA restrictions in box 9A.
- **Series 4: Videotapes, 2003 & undated (1 Box [10], 0.25 linear ft.)**  
Series 4 contains two videotapes, one VHS and one Beta. These are video-recordings of Isasi-Díaz lectures or presentations.
- **Series 5: Audiotapes, 1997-2001 (1 Box [11], 0.25 linear ft.)**  
Series 5 contains audio-recordings of lectures or presentations by Isasi-Díaz. There is a 3 tape series on "Spirituality and Justice." Some portions may be in Spanish.
- **Series 6: Sister Fund: Theological Renaissance Project, Nov. 2000 – Sept. 2007 (1 Box, 0.25 linear ft.)** **RESTRICTED**  
Series 6 contains reports, writings and correspondence related to the Sister Fund: Theological Renaissance Project. Also included are some papers regarding a Women Centered Theology group, which overlapped in membership with the Theological Renaissance Project.
- **Series 7: Professional Activities and Awards, Jan. 1993 – May, 2006 (1 Box, 0.25 linear ft.)**  
Series 7 contains material regarding professional activities, such as student trips, academic awards and course evaluations. This series also contains color, black and white photos.
- **Series 8: Correspondence: Professional and Personal, Dec. 1988 – Aug. 2007 (1 Box, 0.50 linear ft.)**  
Series 8 contains professional and personal correspondence in the form of letters and e-mail communications. This series also contains greeting cards and a group photo.

## Processing

When the Burke Library acquired Isasi-Díaz's papers, an attempt was made to maintain the original order she imposed throughout the course of her career. However, some limited rationalization was introduced for ease of access. Folded materials were flattened. Newspaper clippings were photocopied on acid free paper. Staples, rubber bands, and metal clips were removed and replaced with plastic clips. All materials were placed in acid-free folders and boxes.
