

#### **Institutional History**

Created in 1976 in Dar-es Salaam, Tanzania, the Ecumenical Association of Third World Theologians is a group of representative voices of men and women committed to the task of theological work within local communities, particularly those categorized as "developing" countries of Africa, Asia, and Latin America. EATWOT's aim is to engage in the task of theological dialogue within such communities, including grassroots social and religious movements. Much of EATWOT's efforts are directed toward issues of inequalities such as poverty, marginalization, and domination. Realizing that traditional theology with its European origination and Westernized context failed to sufficiently meet the needs of the Third World, the founders of EATWOT established a forum designed to address the specific concerns of Third World contexts. EATWOT aims to develop contextual models of theology that involve praxis for liberation from oppression.

Some of EATWOT's major goals include interpreting the Gospel in Third World contexts, organizing meetings of Third World theologians, and publishing new theological endeavors in different native languages. In order to accomplish their goals, one of EATWOT's main activities includes annual conferences on the national, regional, and intercontinental levels. In addition, two commissions—the Theological Commission and Women's Commission—work towards concerns specific to their respective fields. EATWOT also produces two publications: *Voices From the Third World*, a bi-annual theological journal that includes papers written by its members and book reviews, and a quarterly Newsletter, an exchange of information among its members and partners. Membership is open to persons born and/or serving in the Third World context. Members of EATWOT are actively engaged in the theological task of interpreting the Gospel as it relates to socio-political issues, particularly ones involving justice from oppressive forces. #### **Collection Scope and Content Note**

Each collection includes administrative records, including financial statements and conference materials, correspondence among executive council members, conference papers, and publications. Where dates are not given in the Contents description, the dates are covered by the 5 year terms reflected in the series title. The collection is organized into series according to EATWOT's Five-Year Terms of Executive Committee membership.

#### • Series 1: First Five-Year Term, 1975 – 1981 (13 boxes, 6 lin. ft.)

This series contains administrative records documenting the earliest stages of the foundation of EATWOT. Included are drafts of the first EATWOT constitutions, correspondence of executive committee members, financial records, including donor information, and membership forms. Programs during the First Five-Year Term include EATWOT's first 1976 conference in Dar es Salaam, followed by four consecutive annual conferences. All conference materials include papers and publications. A copy of the first volume of *Voices From the Third World* is included, and the series concludes with regional meetings.

- Series 2: Second Five-Year Term, 1981 1986 (16 boxes, 7.25 lin. ft.)
  Within this series are administrative documents, including constitution drafts, correspondence of the executive committee and members, financial records, and membership forms. The Second Five-Year Term covers several commission and consultation meetings, such as two conferences organized by the Women's Commission. EATWOT's Sixth International Conference in 1983 and Second General Assembly in 1986 are included during this term. The series ends with copies of several article and book publications by EATWOT members, as well as regional conferences.
- Series 3: Third Five-Year Term, 1986 1992 (8 boxes, 3.5 lin. ft.)
  In this series there are administrative records following the same pattern of the Five-Year Terms, such as correspondence, financial documents, and membership forms, including member photographs. Notable programs within the Third Five-Year Term include the Third General Assembly in Nairobi, two Asian Women's Meetings, and the Third Asian Theological Conference in Seoul. Several publications of articles and books written by EATWOT members are also included in this term. The series concludes with programs by EATWOT's Latin American region, including several conference materials in Spanish.
- <u>Series 4: Fourth Five-Year Term, 1992 1996 (3 boxes, 1.5 lin. ft.)</u>
  This series contains correspondence and circular letters by executive council, regional reports, financial records, and updated membership list. The Fourth General Assembly in Tagaytay and administrative records of the Evaluation Commission and Women's Commission are included during this term. The series concludes with several international and intercontinental meetings, EATWOT's book projects, and significant meetings within the Asia region.
- <u>Series 5: Fifth Five-Year Term, 1996 2001 (3 boxes, 1.5 lin. ft.)</u>
  Within this series membership forms include curriculum vitae with photographs, and the correspondence among the executive council involves partner organizations with First World countries. Documents from the Fifth General Assembly in Ecuador are found in this term. The series ends with activities from the Women's Commission and regional meetings from Africa, Asia, Latin America, and US minorities.

### **Processing**

Metal clips and staples were removed from materials and folded items were flattened. Materials were placed in new acid-free folders and boxes. Acidic items were separated from one another by interleaving with acid-free paper as needed. Any items in an advanced state of deterioration, including photographs, were placed in Mylar envelopes. Sister Virginia Fabella's original notation for the organization of many of the documents in the collection has been retained as a note on folders.
