- Total of 21 points in Political Science.
- **One** of the following Political Theory Courses must be taken:
 W 4133 *Political Thought: Classical & Medieval*
 W 4134 *Modern Political Thought*
 COCI F1101 & F1102 *Contemporary Civilization - note that both semesters must be taken.*
Though this sequence equals 8 points, you may only count 3 points toward the major.
- **Two** of the following Introductory Courses must take be taken:
 W 1201 *Introduction to American Government & Politics*
 V 1501 *Introduction to Comparative Politics*
 V 1601 *Introduction to International Politics*
- Students must choose a main and a second subfield from the 4 subfields of political science: American Politics, Comparative Politics, International Politics, & Political Theory.
- A maximum of 9 transfer credits allowed. Transfer credits require the approval of an undergraduate adviser.
- Courses with grades of “D” may not be applied toward any concentration requirement.
- A grade of “Pass” is only acceptable for the **first** course applied toward the concentration.
