Qualifications: Masters' level or equivalent experience with a strong quantitative background—for example—biostatistics, epidemiology, MPH, psychology or sociology. This person should be proficient in SPSS and be capable of handling logistic regression models. Excellent verbal and interpersonal communication skills are also required.

Job Description: The job entails gathering data, interviewing research subjects, data management and analysis, supervision of volunteers and part-time research assistants, as well as assistance with grant and manuscript preparation. The general subject matter is "descriptive ethics" -- empirical research regarding questions of moral importance. Particular interests are ethical issues in human subjects research.

This is a full-time position, essentially M-F, 9-5. There is some flexibility in these hours (e.g., 8-4, or 9:30-5:30). Infrequently, at times of grant or publication deadlines, some extra hours will be expected.

Expected start date is July 1, 2008. Applicants must be committed to staying in the position until the project is completed (2 years).

The starting salary range is \$40-45,000 per year with full benefits.
