

SECURITY ALERT

ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

On June 15, 2007 at about 5:10 p.m., an employee was the victim of an attempted robbery as she walked down the steps of Morningside Park at W. 116 st.. A male approached her and put a gun to her face, demanding her property. A second male stood nearby. The suspects fled the scene when passersby approached. The police responded and conducted a search with the victim, but the suspects escaped. The victim provided the following description;

#1 male/black/dark complexion/15-17 yrs/5'6"/very thin/very short hair/wearing an oversize white tee shirt and dungaree shorts, carrying what appeared to be an automatic pistol.

#2 male black/light complexion/15-17 yrs/5'6/ thin/very short hair.
