**Major in Hispanic Studies**

Eleven courses (33 points): four required foundation courses; six electives (a minimum of three 3000- or 4000-level electives in SPPO); and one Senior Seminar.

**Hispanic Studies with Specialization**

Fourteen courses (42 points): four required foundation courses; nine electives (three 3000- or 4000-level electives in SPPO and six in a chosen field, three of which must be related to Hispanic Studies); and a Senior Seminar. With permission, the Senior Seminar may be taken in the Department or program of the specialization, provided the student's seminar project covers a Hispanic topic. Students who take the seminar outside SPPO may count it as the third non-SPPO elective related to Hispanic Studies and may take a fourth elective in SPPO. The field must be chosen in consultation with the DUS. Possibilities include Anthropology, Art History, Economics, Film, Gender Studies (IRWAG), History, Latino Studies, Latin American Studies, Music, Political Science, Sociology, and Urban Studies.

**Concentration in Hispanic Studies**

Eight courses (24 points): four required foundation courses; four electives (a minimum of three 3000- or 4000-level courses in SPPO)
