Nothing like this arbitrary interference with personal rights exists in the civilized world outside of Russia. If a postal censorship were to interfere with the circulation of ideas in our country, it can do the same with any other. Under such a system of "government by official ratings," uncontrolled guarantees of freedom of speech and of the press become the utmost mockery.

If all kinds of reforms, if freedom can approach this subject with absolutely clean hands, as the constant deniers of the right of thought and expression, and merely for the sake of the everybody else. This is the very essence of their propaganda, as it is in the case of the fact that independent thinking also can be held in contempt, and that of progress by very direct action. It is, therefore, reprehensible, and so in such the holding in the welfare of mankind, they take the lead, as they are doing in New York, Chicago, and elsewhere, and all in other hands. Americans to come up to standards which they have raised. Without free speech, democracy is not only a thing, it will not always be in the long run to expand and flourish.

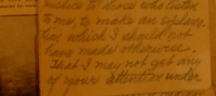
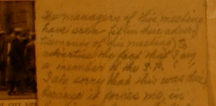

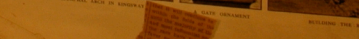

BUILDING THE SOCIAL SYSTEM

It is generally assumed that the only way to get out of the capitalist system is by force. But a new school of thought is appearing which holds that sabotage is a necessary and legitimate weapon in the hands of the working class.

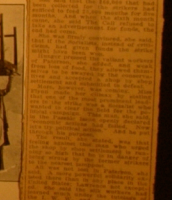
The idea is that by deliberately destroying property and equipment, the workers can bring the capitalist system to a halt and force a change in the social order.

This school of thought is based on the theory that the capitalist system is inherently unstable and that sabotage is a natural outgrowth of the class struggle.

Proponents of this theory argue that sabotage is a more effective and less costly way of fighting the capitalist system than open warfare. They claim that it can be carried out by individuals and small groups, and that it can be kept secret.

They also argue that sabotage is a necessary response to the violence and oppression of the capitalist system. They claim that it is a way of taking the law into one's own hands.

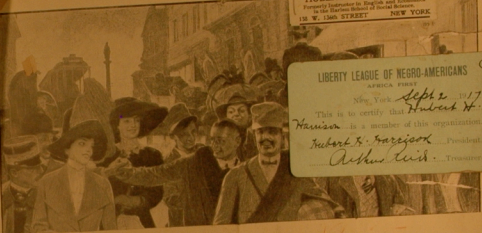
