Dr Fullilove is a member of the Federal Advisory Committee to the Center for Complimentary and Alternative Medicine [NCCAM] at the NIH and for five years, between 1999 and 2004, was the co-chair of the Federal Advisory Committee to the CDC and HRSA on AIDS [The CHAC].
