John Loike is the Co-Director for Graduate Studies in the Department of Physiology and Cellular Biophysics at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. He also serves as Faculty Associate, Center for Bioethics, Columbia University, Advisory Board member of the Columbia University Center for the Study of Science and Religion, creator and faculty editor of the Columbia University Journal of Bioethics, and course instructor for Frontiers in Bioethics offered at Columbia College. His research focuses on how human white blood cells combat infection and cancer. In addition, Dr. Loike has published many articles on Bioethics in Kennedy Institute of Ethics Journal, Tradition, Israel Journal of Bioethics, and lectures internationally on Bioethics. He has co-organized several national and international conferences on genetics and Bioethics. His last conference was a scientist-Rabbinical dialogue on bioethical aspects of stem cell research and reproductive medicine and was held in Israel and sponsored by Columbia University, and Bar-Ilan University. He was recently featured in Businessweek Magazine and in a video interview for Businessweek online.
