Class Participation: The students were less prepared than they might normally have been, due to the fact that there was a paper draft due the day of my observation. Faced with this fact, Professor Stanton adjusted the lesson in such a way as to ensure participation by focusing on elements of the text that could be discussed in a more general way.
Overall Impression: I was very impressed with Professor Stanton's ability to adjust to the conditions of the classroom, and provide an analysis of the text woven very naturally into the responses she elicited from the students. Her teaching showed a deep knowledge of the text, as well as the cultural and historical background of the time in which it was written. I thought it was a very good class.
