Since 2002, Richard N. Winfield has regularly taught courses in comparative mass media law and American mass media and Internet law at Columbia Law School and Fordham Law School in New York City. He serves of counsel to Clifford Chance US LLP and leads the media law reform programs of the International Senior Lawyers Project, which he co-founded in 2000. Since 2006 he has served as Chairman of the World Press Freedom Committee.
