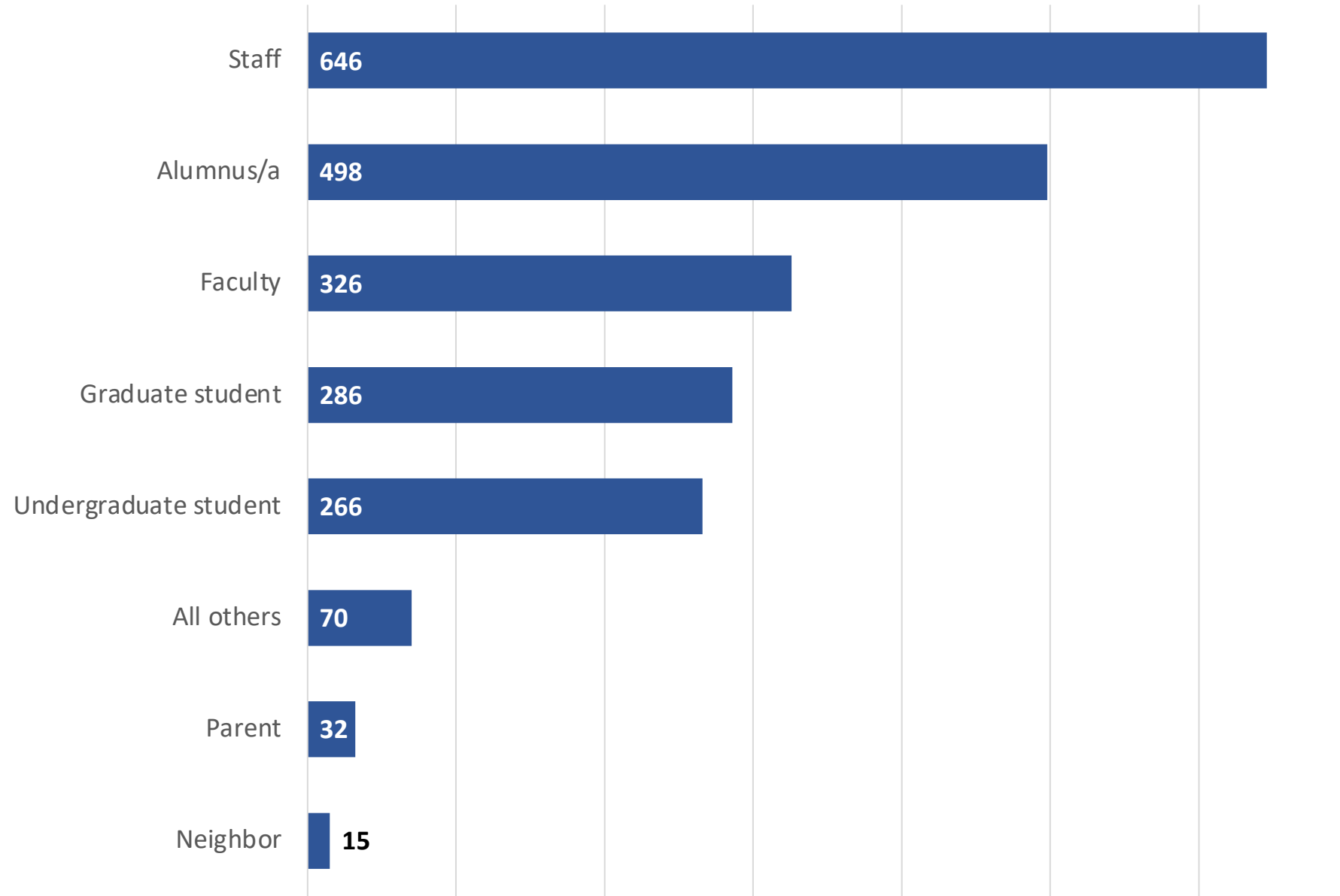

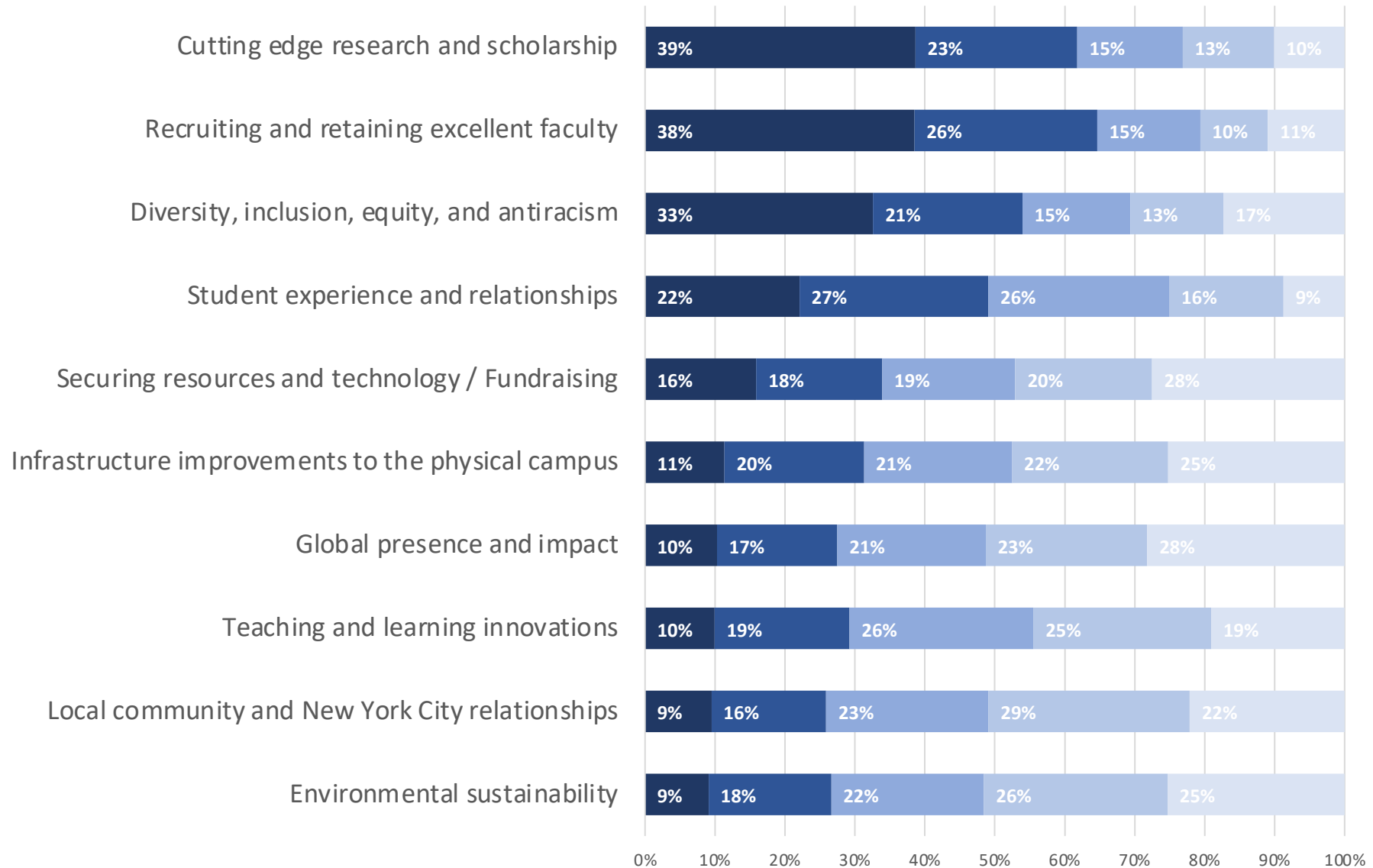
SURVEY PARTICIPATION

- Data was collected between June 6, 2022 and June 24, 2022.
- Overall, the survey had a total of 2,293 respondents.
- Not all participants responded to every question in the survey. Partial survey responses are included.
- The survey is one input to the broader information gathering process, which also includes interviews and advisory committee discussions.

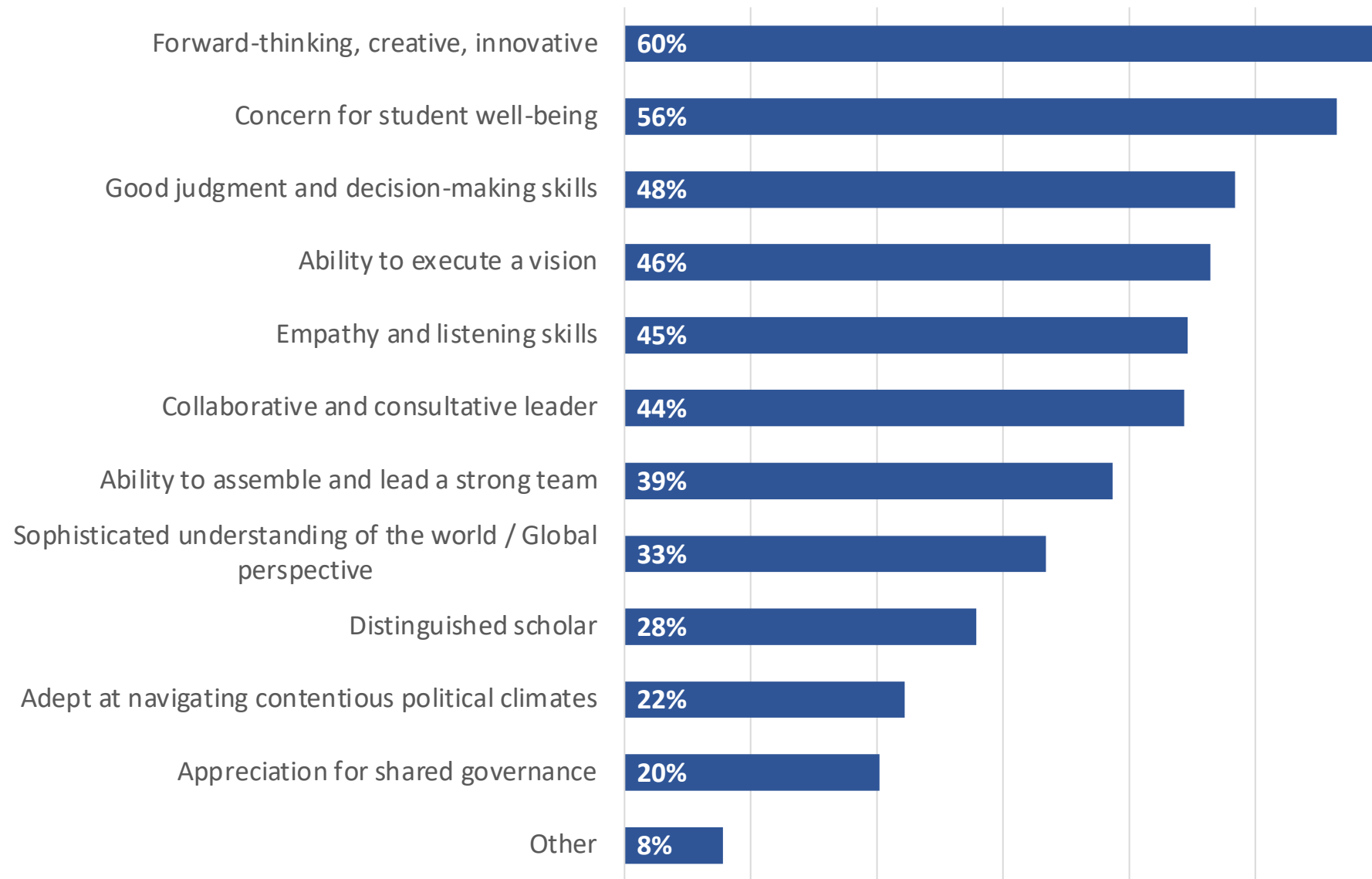

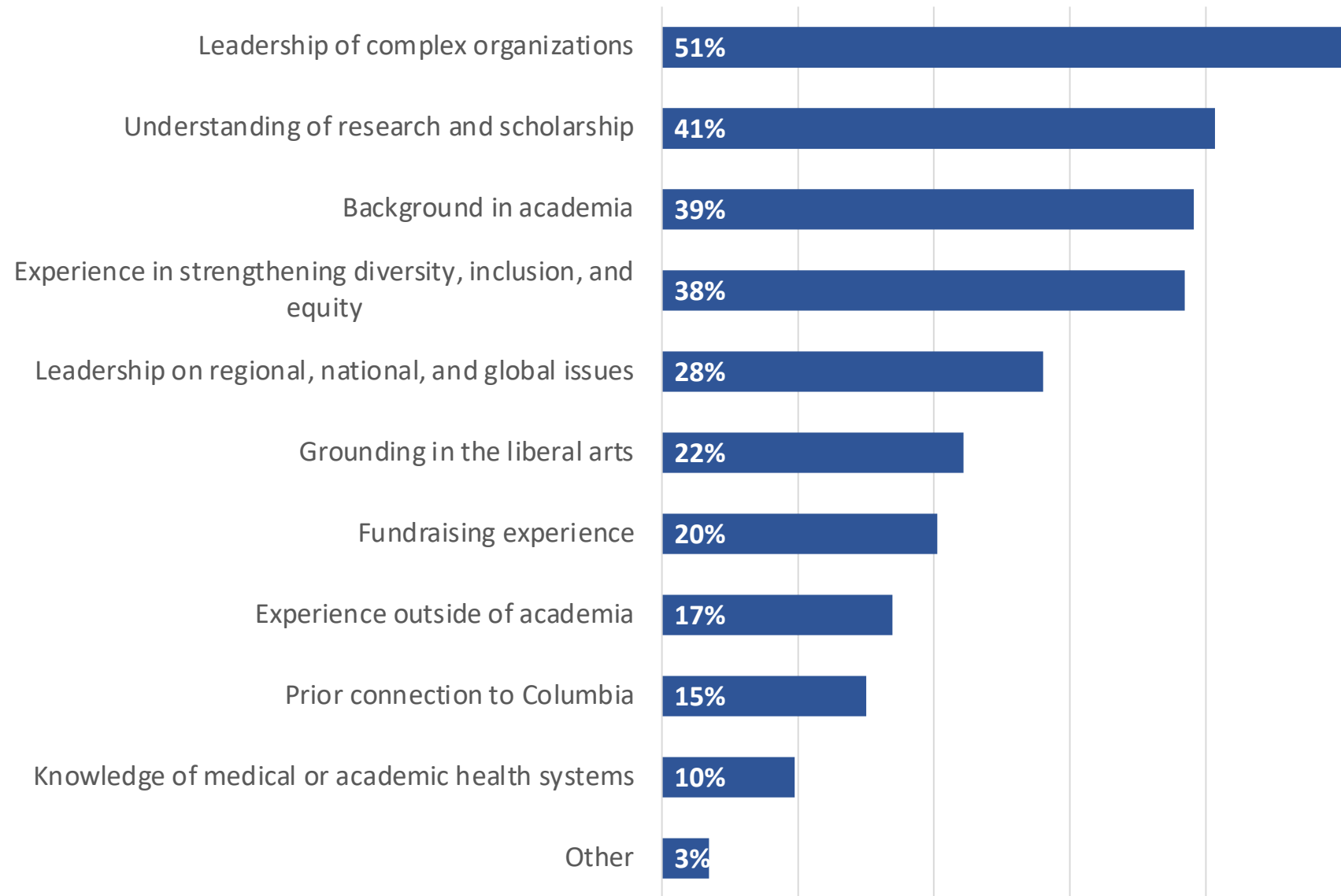

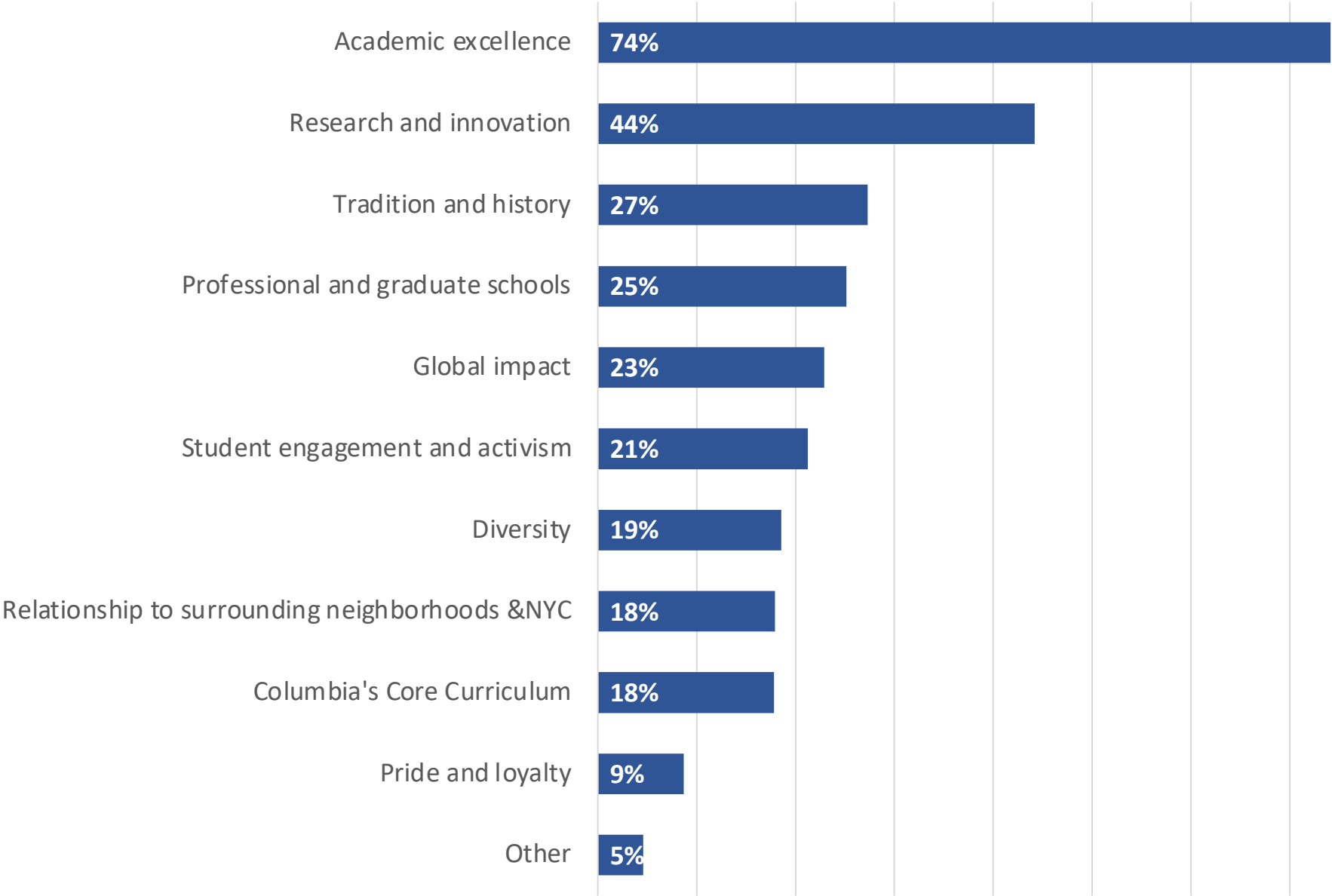
