The Main Goals of the Course

Second Year Japanese I focuses on the mastery of basic Japanese grammar in the four language skills (speaking, listening, reading and writing). In this course you will learn to use and understand complex sentences. You will also learn to handle a variety of everyday situations. More aspects of Japanese culture will be introduced throughout the course.

Course Requirements

1. Everyday participation in class is necessary for learning, therefore, you must attend class on time. (You would be surprised at how much you would miss if you miss even a part of one class!) If you are absolutely unable to attend class, please submit a written explanation (such as a doctor's note).
2. You are encouraged to speak Japanese as much as possible in class, and outside of class whenever you have the opportunity to do so (such as with your instructors/classmates, at the Japanese Chat Club, etc).
3. If you are late for the daily quiz, you will receive only half credit for the day's attendance.
4. **No make-up** will be permitted for quizzes, examinations, or individual sessions for speaking aloud.
5. Homework should be submitted when due. No credit will be given for late submission.
However, if you must turn an assignment in late, you should still do so, in order to get feedback from your instructor.
6. Students are expected to spend at least two hours at home studying per class session.
This home preparation includes reviewing, doing homework, previewing Grammatical Notes and MP III listening, etc.
7. No auditing or "registration credit" is allowed. No PASS/FAIL is allowed.
8. A one-week absence from class without notifying the instructor will be interpreted as an unofficial withdrawal from the course.

Recording

In order to improve your accent, intonation, and pauses, you will record yourself and receive feedback from a teacher.

録音① & ⑥ :

You will practice reading a passage and record yourself.

録音②-⑤ :

1. You will listen to a model recording and practice until your accent, intonation, and pauses sound like the given model.
2. You will record yourself. (1 回目)
3. Receive feedback.
4. Take the feedback you received into account and practice reading the passage.
5. Record yourself the second time around. (2 回目)

The deadline will be at 11:30 am on Monday of the recording week. For example, the first recording is due by 11:30 am on 09/16. EXCEPTION: 録音④ is due by 11:30 am on Wednesday, 11/06.
