

PHD IN FRENCH WITH CONCENTRATION IN COMP. LIT. CHECKLIST

PhD requirements are distributed over the course of the MA and MPhil. Distribution fulfillment begins in the first year. For the MA, students must take classes in 4 of the following seven fields: "Middle Ages," "Renaissance," "Classical," "Enlightenment," "Nineteenth Century," "Twentieth and Twenty First Century," and "Francophone."

- ♦ MA Degree Electives: 2 electives may be taken outside of the Department with permission of the DGS; 2 electives may be taken for R credit.
- ♦ Students pursuing the concentration in Comparative Literature and Society will take an additional 5 classes in the French department after the MA including Pedagogy. One course may be taken for R credit.
