- Students must choose a major and minor subfield from the 4 subfields of political science: American politics, comparative politics, international relations, & political theory
- No courses may double-count for two separate majors/concentrations or programs.
- A maximum of 12 transfer credits in Political Science allowable. This includes study abroad and AP credit. Transfer credit must be approved by an undergraduate adviser.
- Barnard colloquia may only fulfill the seminar requirement at the discretion of the DUS.
- Courses with a grade of "D" may not be applied toward any major requirements.
- A grade of "Pass" is acceptable for only the **first** course taken for the major.
